Please drop in for coffee (POST PANDEMIC), read a newspaper, go through our referral binders, visit, use the telephone. All programs and services are GENERALLY (PRE-PANDEMIC) free at Red Road, and transportation is provided for those attending programs. GO ONLINE FOR INDIGENOUS EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND FUN!!

Counseling, specific referrals, resumes and home visitation is also available through appointments and usually on a 'first come first serve' basis. Red Road programs of culture, self esteem, literacy, tutoring, 'Baby, Think It Over', Tobacco and Drug prevention are going on throughout the year at various centers; as well as in the society's meeting rooms (pre-pandemic). Our 10 -12 week formal programs run from September to December in the Fall and January to April in the winter. In the summer we have 1-2 day workshops rather than weekly programs. CALL AHEAD OF TIME FOR EVENTS; IF IT IS RAINING, COLD OR TOO WARM -20 C, OR +30 C, AN EVENT MAY BE CANCELLED AND/OR WE MAY BE CLOSED STILL DUE TO COVID 19!!
