All programs and services are free at Red Road, and childcare and transportation is provided for those attending programs. 'Baby, Think It Over', Counseling, culture, EARLY CHILDHOOD, HOME VISITATION. INDIGENOUS FAMILY SUPPORT, IN HOME SUPPORT, literacy, PARENTING EDUCATION, resumes, self esteem, specific referrals, tutoring, Tobacco and Drug prevention and YOUTH; are going on throughout the year at various centers; as well as in the society's meeting rooms. Our 10 -12 week formal programs run from September to December in the Fall; and January to April are the Red Road programs of in the winter. Counselling and Therapy programs are available through appointments; and generally, run on a 'first come first serve' basis. In the summer we have 1-2 day workshops rather than weekly programs. CALL AHEAD OF TIME FOR EVENTS; IF IT IS RAINING, -20 C, OR +30 C, AN EVENT MAY BE CANCELLED AND/OR WE MAY BE CLOSED!!
