towards actual construction. Therefore; 4 days at River Cree this year (rather than the just over 2 days that we had last year); as we have lots to share and discuss. The poster will be ready this

week; sooo book your spots now as the rates are very

reasonable. AND/OR get involved!

Since we did not have our annual *Kiwani Owapi* spring celebration this year; (after 25 year plus celebrations since 1993); we are having a *Welcoming Back of the Thunders* April 21, 2022 in Rm 333, from 10 am to 2 pm, at THE ORANGE HUB. Please join us (see poster on website).
