Please drop in for coffee, read a newspaper, access referrals, visit, use the telephone AND DESKTOP. All programs and services are free at Red Road; childcare and transportation is provided for those attending programs. 'Baby, Think It Over', counseling, culture, EARLY CHILDHOOD, HOME VISITATION. INDIGENOUS FAMILY SUPPORT, IN HOME SUPPORT, literacy, PARENT EDUCATION, resumes, self esteem, specific referrals, Tobacco and Drug prevention, tutoring, and YOUTH programs; are on-going throughout the year at various centers; as well as in the society's meeting rooms. Our 10 -12 week formal programs run from September to December in the Fall; and January to April in the winter. Red Road Counseling and Therapy programs are available through appointments; and generally, run on a 'first come first serve' basis. In the summer we have 1-2 day workshops rather than weekly programs. CALL AHEAD FOR THE TIME OF EVENTS; IF IT IS RAINING, -20 C, AND COLDER; OR +30 C AND HIGHER, AN EVENT MAY BE CANCELLED AND/OR WE MAY BE CLOSED!!
